
HOLIDAYS







WELCOME

Built at the very beginning of the last century, Manowce has remained loyal to the vision of grandeur upon which it was founded as a luxurious rural retreat. Located in vast woods and right on the shore of a large lagoon, Manowce lets you and your family and friends enjoy far-reaching views over the waters. We look forward to welcoming you soon, so you can see for yourself just how special Manowce really is.

PROPERTY

Manowce is a historic property uniquely located in northwestern Poland, surrounded by vast woods, far from residential areas and set right on the shore of a large bay next to the Baltic Sea. Despite its remote location, Manowce is only 40 minutes from Szczecin (Stettin) and 2.5 hours from Berlin and its airport.

The Manowce Palace at Trzebieradz (known as Haffhorst prior to 1945) was built at the beginning of the 20th century in the neoclassical style. The investor and first owner was Georg Wegner, chief medical officer and director of a hospital in Szczecin. During the Second World War, the property was used by the National Socialist People's Welfare organization (*Nationalsozialistische Volkswohlfahrt*; NSV) as *Gauschule* (training centre for party members) and *Mutterheim* (shelter for mothers). From the end of the 1940s to the beginning of the 1990s the palace served as a summer camp for children.

Whether you are traveling alone or with family and friends, we will be pleased to accommodate you for as many nights as you like (at least two) in July or August, and on weekends in the other months. You can also use all the common spaces in the palace for entertainment. There are a few lounges that are the perfect location for talks, drinks, games, music and movies.

GROUP HOLIDAYS

Manowce is one of the very few five-star locations in this part of Europe where you can hire the property for exclusive holiday use, for yourself only or with your friends. Exclusive means that there will be no other guests during your stay (however, part of the villa is a private home). We will be pleased to accommodate your group of at least fifteen people for a week or two from June to September, and to cater for breakfast, lunch, dinner and drinks.

We always recommend that group bookings are made well ahead of time, so that we can ensure exclusivity on your chosen dates. Also, we will need some time to work out with you an attractive programme of various activities for your stay and to book the vendors who will provide these services. At Manowce, you can sunbathe on the private shore of the lagoon, swim in the bay and hunt for mushrooms in the woods, and you'll have complimentary use of our kayaks, SUP boards, fishing boat with rods, and bicycles. ACCOMMODATION

From opulent suites to comfortable bedrooms, our accommodation boasts original features and is designed with complete luxury in mind. Manowce offers three stunning, luxurious apartments and thirteen double bedrooms, accommodating up to thirty-three guests in total, or forty-two including sofa beds and extra beds in some rooms. All the rooms have en-suite bathrooms and large televisions, and there is Wi-Fi access throughout. Due to the historic status of our property, the bedrooms are not air-conditioned, but there's a continuous refreshing breeze from the lagoon.

PALACE BEDROOMS

Situated on the second floor of the palace, these atmospheric double rooms are rich in modern comfort and historic period features like antique wardrobes. The super-king bed can be twinned to accommodate two friends rather than a couple. These rooms come in different shapes and sizes, but all offer a touch of luxury. Guests who have problems with climbing stairs may find it difficult to access these rooms as they are on the second floor.

ANNEX BEDROOMS

On the first floor of the historic annex to the palace building there are seven contemporary rooms with beds that can be doubles or twins. Because part of that building was a stable, we have maintained the rustic style of the interiors. Some of these rooms have wonderful views to the bay, just 50 metres away.

SUITES

Beautifully appointed, historic and luxurious, the suites offer a sense of space and a touch of luxury, with a super-king-size bed, antique dressing tables, comfortable contemporary sofas and garden views, as well as all our usual amenities, including an en-suite bathroom, TV, tea- and coffee-making facilities and complimentary Wi-Fi.

COMMON SPACES

Besides the bedrooms, our guests can enjoy the grounds, the lower-ground floor and the upper-ground floor of the palace.

GROUNDS

The palace is surrounded by lovely gardens and lawns. The property borders the lagoon, and you can access the water directly from our shore. The bay is very shallow for the first 100 metres, so kids can play safely in the water. You can sunbathe on deckchairs next to the water, or play volleyball and other games on the lawns. In the evenings, we sometimes use the barbecue.

LOWER GROUND FLOOR

The lower-ground floor of the palace is where you can enjoy breakfast, and you may want to spend evenings here with your companions if it's raining outside. The kitchen here is the domain of our chef. There are two lounges that are the perfect location for talks, drinks, games, music and movies. You can find a billiards table and a dartboard there. For children we have a corner with child-sized tables and chairs.

UPPER GROUND FLOOR

If you want to spend evenings in truly grand and historic surroundings, welcome to the ground floor. On fine days and evenings you and your companions can sit on the terrace overlooking the bay. Inside, in our Master Lounge, you can sink into our sumptuous sofas and sip drinks or enjoy a cup of coffee. The upper-ground floor also has two sitting rooms for chatting in private, playing cards and other pastimes. In the Great Hall we serve lunches and dinners.











PRICES

INDIVIDUAL BOOKINGS

We welcome all holiday bookings for July and August, and for weekends in the other months. Our holiday price includes the room and breakfast, as well as complimentary use of all the onsite facilities, equipment and common spaces offered to our guests. At Manowce you can also enjoy lunch and dinner and various drinks, which are served at our à la carte prices.

The bedroom rates are from 120 to 240 euros per room per night for single use, and from 180 to 300 euros per room per night for double occupancy. The suites cost from 180 to 340 euros per room per night for single use, and from 240 to 440 euros per room per night for double occupancy. Sofa beds and extra beds cost 60 euros each per night for single use, and 120 euros per night for double occupancy. Weekend and high season prices may be higher. There is no charge for children under three, as they either sleep in a cot or together with their parents. GROUP HOLIDAYS

Our group holiday offer is composed of three elements:

The charge that covers the three components listed above is 300 euros per person per day. Discounts for kids apply. The charge includes accommodation in guest rooms. There are additional charges for suites. The minimum group size is fifteen adults or children aged over twelve, and the minimum stay is seven days. No pets allowed. Please send us an enquiry and we will send you a detailed offer, including floorplans and pictures of all the common spaces and bedrooms so that you can allocate them to your family and friends. We will let you know if your preferred dates are still available. We welcome group bookings from June to September.

If you want to entertain your companions during the day, then along with swimming in the bay and mushrooming in the woods, we can organise activities such as kayaking, sailing, fishing, cycling, horse riding and golf.

We have terrific relationships with companies that specialize in offering fun and inspiring activities and exercises. We would be happy to arrange any of these activities on your behalf. For instance, you can reach the open waters of the Baltic Sea in half an hour by motorboat, so sailing and rod-fishing enthusiasts can enjoy both the bay and the sea.

Fancy a game of golf? With an hour's journey by car or motorboat you can reach six eighteen-hole golf courses, three in Poland and three in Germany. We can get you there and bring you back. If required, lessons are available, tailored to suit the needs of the individual. They are suitable for experienced golfers and beginners.

Don't forget Berlin, only a 2.5-hour drive from Manowce and perfect for a day trip. If you enjoy architecture, you should see Berlin's landmarks, like the Brandenburg Gate and the Berlin Television Tower, and we always advise visiting the Charlottenburg Palace and Park and especially the Sanssouci Palace and Park in Potsdam. For shopping lovers, there is the famous Kurfürstendamm, the most expensive address in the capital city and home to the most exclusive brands, including Europe's biggest department store, KaDeWe.

Manowce is located on the shore of the Szczecin Lagoon, just 35 kilometres (22 miles) from Szczecin and 185 kilometres (115 miles) from the centre of Berlin. Because Manowce is located in the forest, please refer to the map below, which will guide you or your driver for the last mile.


